These changes are detailed below

After consultation with Bowls England and our Insurers Sutton Winson we have been advised that we should amend the class of membership in the Constitution to ensure that we are fully covered for any person who goes on the green.

The committee therefore would like to change the membership section of the constitution as follows:

Existing Constitution

Membership

- Membership of the Club shall be open to any person, regardless of race, age, gender, sexual orientation, religious belief or ability, who completes the membership application process and pays the relevant subscription/joining fee as determined by the Club.

Class of Membership

- Full Member
- Junior Member (16 years and under)
- Associate Member
- Guest member

Amendments recommended by Bowls England to fully comply with insurance cover –proposed additions in red

Membership

Membership of the Club shall be open to any person, regardless of race, age, gender, sexual orientation, religious belief or ability, who completes the membership application process and pays the relevant subscription/joining fee as determined by the Club.

Class of Membership

- Full Member - a bowler who has paid his/her subscription and met the bowling requirements. A full member can access all the other facilities offered at the club.
- Junior Member - (16 years and under)
- Associate Member – a person who can access all the facilities offered at the club except bowls.
- Guest member - a bowler registered/affiliated at another BW/BE registered club who plays at Malmesbury BC on an occasional basis (max. 3 times per season) and is 'signed in' in the Visitors Book by the Captain of the Day.
- Visiting member– a person attending the Club to try the game of Bowls. A visitor will be deemed to be a temporary member of the Club upon signing the Visitors Book.
